What each criterion measures

College Board holds the copyright in the level descriptors, so they are not reprinted here. The criteria and their weightings are below; the wording of each level is in the official document linked above.

- **Context: Stimulus Integration** is worth 5 of the 48 points, scored across 2 levels.
- **Context: Significance** is worth 5 of the 48 points, scored across 2 levels.
- **Perspective** is worth 9 of the 48 points, scored across 3 levels.
- **Argument** is worth 12 of the 48 points, scored across 3 levels.
- **Evidence** is worth 9 of the 48 points, scored across 3 levels.
- **Citation Conventions** is worth 5 of the 48 points, scored across 3 levels.
- **Style** is worth 3 of the 48 points, scored across 3 levels.
