How it is scored

What each criterion measures

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- **Focus** is worth 6 of the 30 points, scored across 6 levels.
- **Elaboration** is worth 6 of the 30 points, scored across 6 levels.
- **Organization** is worth 6 of the 30 points, scored across 6 levels.
- **Conventions** is worth 6 of the 30 points, scored across 6 levels.
- **Integration** is worth 6 of the 30 points, scored across 6 levels.
